**BEHAVIOR & CONDUCT**

Guests and students of Veritas Prep are expected to behave in a socially appropriate manner while on school grounds or at school activities. Guests and students are expected to comply with school rules and regulations, and to be courteous to each other, faculty members, parents, and employees of Veritas Prep. Inappropriate conduct may result in the removal from the event and notification of parent/guardian and guest's school. In the event that I am contacted and advised of an infraction that requires my child leave this event, I will promptly provide or ensure transportation away from the event location.

**ILLNESS OR INJURY**

In the event of illness or injury, the parent/guardian will be contacted. When immediate medical treatment seems essential, Veritas Prep personnel or representatives will contact emergency medical personnel to transport the injured child to an appropriate medical facility.

**DRESS CODE****The dress code for boys is:**

- Hair should be trimmed appropriately. Clean-shaven.
- No dyed hair or hats.
- No earrings.
- Required: Button-down collared dress shirt, belt, dress slacks, socks. Tie and dress jacket/blazer optional.
- Shoes are required, no flip-flops.
- No denim.
- Shirts must be buttoned and tucked in.

**The dress code for girls is:**

- Semi-formal dresses (with at least one shoulder strap with hemline falling no higher than 3" above the knee) or formal palazzo style pants (see below). No visible midriffs or cutouts allowed.
- Neckline (armpit to armpit) must be no lower than four finger widths below the collarbone. The back of the dress cannot fall below the traditional bra line. No visible undergarments. Sheer material may not replace opaque fabric to meet these requirements.
- Palazzo pants must be formal in style: i.e. mid-calf or full length with a minimum bottom leg width of 12". No cut-outs, slits above the calf or see-through fabric. Tops must be tucked in.
- Shoes are required, no flip-flops. No dyed hair or hats.
- Scarves and shawls are allowed, but only if they are not necessary for the dress/top to meet the dress code. No temporary alterations (e.g. pins.)

All students in attendance are expected to honor the intended spirit of the dress code. Ladies should direct any questions to [Mrs. Bruns](#), and gentlemen should inquire of [Mr. Sifert](#). Students who arrive to the dance inappropriately dressed will not be permitted to enter.

**GENERAL RULES/POLICIES**

\*Veritas Prep students shall assume responsibility for his/her guest.

\*All guests must be high school aged

\*A signed and completed Guest Permission Form must be submitted to Mr. Austin by Monday, October 22<sup>nd</sup>.

\*Online ticket sales only. <http://veritasprep.greatheartsacademies.org/academy-life/homecoming-2018/> No ticket sales or guest registrations at the door.

\*Check-in and attendance will be taken at the event. Check-in is from 6:45-7:15pm. All students and guests must arrive no later than **7:15pm** to check-in.

\*Leaving the event site without permission is not permitted. Students leaving without permission will be denied re-entry.

\*Dress code will be strictly enforced. Those in violation of event dress code will be denied entry. No refunds for dress code issues.

\*Vulgar, obscene, or profane language will not be tolerated.

\*Alcohol use or intoxication, tobacco, drug use (legal or illegal), and weapons are prohibited.
